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### Conditions of use – cat trap

If I seize an unidentified cat\* I must within 12 hours of trapping the cat, deliver the cat to:-

1. A registered veterinary surgeon, or
2. A facility for the care of cats,

**Note: penalties apply under the Dog and Cat Management Act, 1995 to any person who fails to comply with the above.**

#### \*Identified cats

Any cat which has been identified must be released immediately - unharmed.

An identified cat is one which has:-

- A collar or disc around its neck bearing the name, address or telephone number of the owners of the cat or other person entitled to possession of the cat; or
- A tattoo "M" inside an ear indicating a microchip has been implanted

Note: penalties apply under the Dog and Cat Management Act, 1995, Section 79, for any person who interferes with or removes the means by which a cat is identified;- a maximum penalty of \$5000.00 applies.

**I confirm that I have read, understood and agree to the above conditions of hire of cat traps. I understand that cats in traps are not accepted at Council facilities. I agree to return the empty trap/ s in a clean condition without damage and I understand that the return of my deposit is dependent upon this and that any late hire fees imposed may be taken, in the first instance, from this deposit.**
