- A FEE OF \$15 PER NIGHT APPLIES FOR ALL **OVERNIGHT STAYS**
- PETS ARE PERMITTED BUT MUST NOT CAUSE DISTURBANCE TO OTHERS. DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON LEADS AT ALL TIMES
- FIRES PERMITTED WITHIN PROVIDED FIRE BUCKETS, OTHER THAN ON TOTAL FIRE BAN DAYS AND DURING THE DECLARED FIRE DANGER SEASON - BYO FIRE WOOD
- GAS BBQS MUST NOT BE LIT ON TOTAL FIRE BAN DAYS

By entering and allowing your vehicle to remain in this campground, you agree to the following conditions and those included in relevant campground policies. If you do not accept these terms and conditions, you must immediately remove your vehicle from the campground.

Sites cannot be reserved, including by way of personal items (e.g. tents, chairs, signage, etc.) being left in the area for the intended purpose of camping there at a later time.

All persons camping in the area must, in addition to complying with the above conditions, comply with all applicable laws and Council by-laws including (but not limited to) activities in relation to the lighting of fires and interference with vegetation. Penalties for non-compliance apply.

Fires permitted within provided fire buckets, other than on total fire ban days or during the declared fire danger season. Must supply your own fire wood.

Pets are permitted but must not cause disturbance to others. If pets are causing a disturbance for other campers, you may be required to leave the campground.

The peaceful enjoyment of the campground and its facilities by all campers is important to Council.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The District Council of Loxton Waikerie will not, under any circumstances, be liable or responsible for any damage or loss; and all injury, loss or damage to person or property is at the risk of the persons entering and/or leaving their vehicles in this area.

No other person or organisation other than Council has the authority to vary, waive or excuse compliance with any of the terms and conditions.

- Sites are provided on a first come, first served basis
- Camping sites may not be reserved in any way
